No, sponsorship payments must be paid in full. ALL SPONSORSHIP PAYMENTS MUST BE PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS OR YOU WILL LOSE YOUR SPONSORSHIP!!!

How will the list of what is available be tracked?

As things sell out, the ability to purchase the opportunity will go away.

I am not currently a chamber member, can I still sponsor? NO! Only chamber members can sponsor.

What members can use credit from their membership for sponsoring? Members at the Premium Membership Tiers have prepaid sponsorship dollars.

While these amounts can be customized, generally they are allocated as such:

- Corporate Investor is \$500
- Key Investor is \$1,000
- Civic Investor is \$2,500
